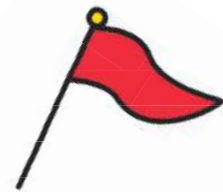

Is your New Year's goal to save money? The following are ways that can help.

Foundational Strategies

- **Create a Budget:** The first and most important step is to understand where your money is going. A budget acts as a plan for your income and expenses. A common method is the **50/30/20 rule**: 50% of after-tax income for needs, 30% for wants, and 20% for savings and debt repayment.
- **Set Clear Goals:** Having specific savings goals (e.g., an emergency fund, a vacation, or retirement) provides motivation. Experts often recommend building an emergency fund that covers three to six months of living expenses.
- **Track Your Spending:** Monitor all your expenses, no matter how small ("ant spending"). Many apps or a simple spreadsheet can help you identify areas where you can cut back.
- **Pay Yourself First & Automate:** Set up automatic transfers from your checking account to a dedicated high-yield savings account or retirement account with each paycheck. This ensures saving is consistent and you are less tempted to spend the money.

Cutting Expenses

Review your spending habits and look for areas to reduce costs:

- **Minimize Dining Out:** Plan your meals, cook at home more often, and pack your lunch to work. Eating out is significantly more expensive than preparing food at home.
- **Reduce Utility Bills:** Save on heating and cooling by adjusting your thermostat by 7 to 10 degrees for eight hours a day. Turn off appliances when not in use and seal insulation leaks.
- **Cut Subscriptions and Services:** Review bank or credit card statements for recurring charges you no longer use, such as streaming services, gym memberships, or apps.
